
### The Venue:

### Transportation from Airport to the place around the venue:

You can take Airport Metro to Dongzhimen Station and then transfer to Subway Line 2, and transger to Line 5 at YongHeGong Station, then get of at HePingLi Bei Jie Station, the venue is very close to the Exit C of HePingLi Bei Jie Station. The Airport Metro is available from 06:00am to 23:10pm. The ticket will cost RMB 25 Yuan. (About 3 Euros)

If you arrive at the airport between 23:10pm to 06:00am, the Airport Metro will not be available; you may need to take a taxi, which will take about RMB 120 Yuan (about 20 Euros) to the place around the venue.

### Local Transportation:

The Venue is located very close to the HePingLi Bei Jie Station of Subway Line 5. You can take subway and get off at HePingLi Bei Jie Station. The place is located about 300M to the Exit C of the station.

### Accommodation:

3. Beijing Longshaoheng Mansion: 3 Star Hotel, 0.8 KM away from the from the Venues, start from 64 Euro/ Room (Max 2 people/ Room)
